


HCAHPS: Communication with Doctors

(Represents patients discharged between July 2015 and June 2016)




HCAHPS: Pain Management (Represents patients discharged between July 2015 and June 2016)


HCAHPS: Communication About Medicines

(Represents patients discharged between July 2015 and June 2016)




HCAHPS: Cleanliness of Hospital Environment

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
